A concert pianist and collaborative pianist, Professor at the Central Conservatory of Music in Beijing, China (CCOM), Huang Meng Meng is the artistic director of the Collaborative Piano Festival of the CCOM. Mr. Huang also serves as the artistic associate directors of the International String Festival of the CCOM and Zhuhai String Master Class.

During a career spanning over a quarter of a century, Huang has performed in all major halls throughout China and more than a dozen countries overseas. He has collaborated with internationally renowned artists such as Sheng Zhongguo, Boris Kuschnir, Nobuko Imai, Julian Rachlin, Dami Kim, Yu Mingqing, Ning Feng, Qin Liwei, Lü Siqing, Yue Lin.

Huang won numerous awards of collaborative pianists in many competitions, including *International Tchaikovsky Competition for Young Musicians*, *Antiquea Marca Firmana International Violin Competition* in Italy, *Hong Kong International Violin Competition*, *Chinese Golden Bell Award for Music*, and all major national string competitions, among many others.

As a recitalist and chamber musician, Huang released dozens of recordings. He has been frequently invited to perform and give masterclasses at the National Center for the Performing Arts in Beijing, and leading conservatories in China. Huang is also a frequent jury member for many piano competitions.
